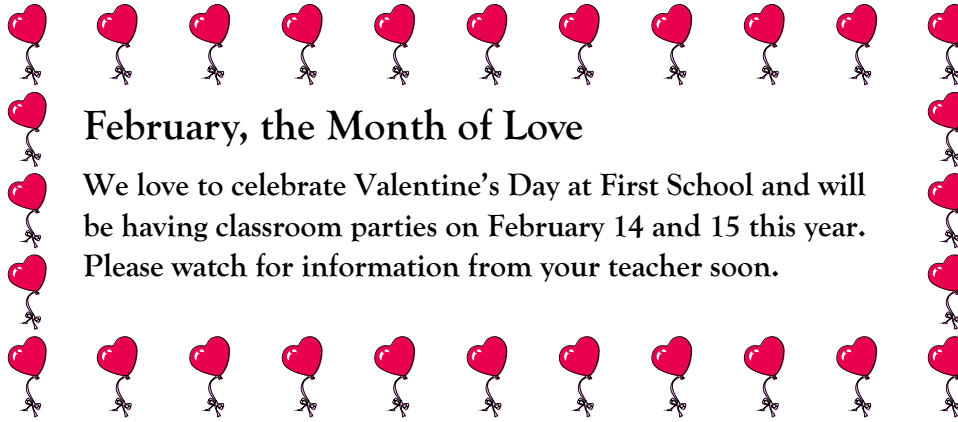

We are offering a young 5's class for the 2023-24 school year. This class is designed for children who turn 5 in May through December. 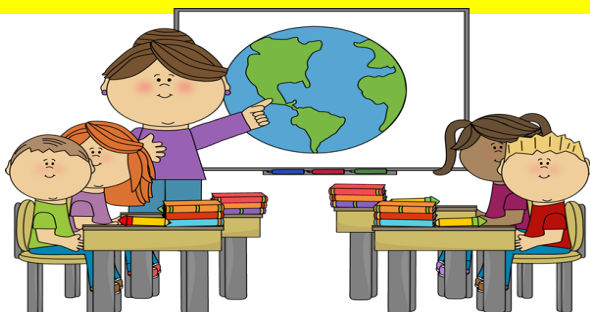
